

RESOLUTION 2023-08

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of *Wellington City* are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS the Wellington City Council recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within their jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”) has required that municipalities review and revise their local multi-hazard mitigation plan every five years to reflect changes in development, progress in local hazard mitigation efforts, and changes in mitigation priorities and submit their revised multi-hazard mitigation plan for review and approval by FEMA to remain eligible for pre-disaster mitigation grant funding; and

WHEREAS the Emergency Services Division of Carbon County has received a grant from FEMA to prepare a multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan in accordance with the requirements of 44.C.F.R. 201.6 and the FEMA “Local Mitigation Planning Handbook”; and

WHEREAS, these requirements include obtaining formal resolutions of participation and support from stakeholder jurisdictions.

hereby intends to support the Plan update initiative by participating with the committee intended to develop revisions and updates to the Carbon County Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
